
INSTRUCTIONS

Please read the instructions carefully before use.

- 1. Denture Cleaner requires 2 x "AA size" batteries, 1.5V, (not included).
- 2. Take out the cleaning compartment (fig. 1) and wash with clean water.
- Wipe the cleaning compartment with a cloth and then place it back on the base unit.
- 4. Open the battery compartment (fig. 3) at the bottom of the base (fig. 2) and insert 2 x "AA size" batteries according to battery + / direction. Close the lid properly.
- 5. Fill the cleaning compartment with water or your own denture cleaner.
- 6. Place the denture(s) into the cleaning compartment, then turn the machine on for 15 minutes. (If denture(s) is stained, light brushing may be necessary).
- 7. 5 minutes of daily denture cleaning is recommended. If your denture(s) has accumulated stain and tar deposits, then clean for 15 minutes daily until stain and tar are removed.
- 8. After each cleaning, use warm water to rinse your denture(s) thoroughly.
- 9. Wash the cleaning compartment with water (fig. 1) and dry with cloth after use.
- 10. TURN OFF the denture cleaner after use.







NOTES

- Before placing denture(s) in the cleaning unit, remove any adhesive.
- This unit will work with any liquid denture cleaner.
- Please do not immerse the main unit in the water.
- Please replace with new batteries if the power gets low.
- Do not mix different battery types together.
- When replacing batteries, replace all batteries at the same time.
- When not in use for a long period, take out the batteries to avoid battery oxides which will damage the unit and impair its function.
